The history of City College is associated with the awakening of the people of Hyderabad who realised the importance of education and established the first city school in the *Dar-ul-uloom* as early as 1865, which was later, converted into a City High School. The school moved into the present grand edifice in 1921. Intermediate sections (F.A) of Osmania University with 30 students were introduced in 1921 under the supervision of the high school with Urdu as the medium of instruction.

The history of City College is associated with the awakening of the people of Hyderabad who realized the importance of education and established the first city school in the Dar-ul-uloom as early as 1865, which was later, converted into a City High School. The school moved into the present grand edifice in 1921. Intermediate sections (F.A) of Osmania University with 30 students were introduced in 1921 under the supervision of the high school with Urdu as the medium of instruction.

In 1929, the school was upgraded to a college and was named as "City College". It became a constituent college of Osmania University. Consequent to the abolition of the Intermediate course (F.A) in Osmania University in the year 1956, the Pre-University Course (P.U.C) was introduced. The B.Sc courses were introduced in 1962 and the institution was named as "City Science College". City College was taken over by the Government from Osmania University in 1965 and was renamed as "Government City Science College".

In 1967, B.A and B.Com courses were added and the college became "Government City College". In the year 1986, Electronics subject was introduced in B.Sc. In 1997, Industrial Microbiology, a vocational course sponsored by UGC was introduced. In 1998, it took the lead in introducing socially relevant restructured courses such as Biotechnology, Biochemistry, B.Sc (Computer Science), B.Com (Computer Applications), B.A Tourism and Travel Management, B.A Office Management. Post Graduate courses, M.Sc Biotechnology (2001) and M.Sc Mathematics (2003), are introduced.

The academic ambience of the institution is enhanced by the exemplary achievements of its outstanding Alumni. Union Cabinet Ministers like Sri Shivaraj Patil, Sri P. Siva Shanker, Chief Ministers like Sri S.B. Chavan, Sri Veerendra Patil and Marri. Chenna Reddy and several Vice-Chancellors, Doctors, Engineers, Scientists, Lawyers, Defence Personnel, Olympians, Arjuna Awardees, Padmashree recipients have been students of this august institution, continuously inspiring the succeeding generations to follow in their path and achieve greater laurels.

GENERAL RULE

- Ragging is strictly prohibited on the College campus.

Ragging Consequences

Ragging incidents within or outside educational institutions devastate the students and destroy their career and lives. The Andhra Pradesh Prohibition of Ragging Act (Act No: 26 of 1997) prohibits 'ragging' in all educational institutions in the State of Andhra Pradesh.

'Ragging' means doing an act, which causes or is likely to cause insult or annoyance or fear or apprehension or threat or intimidation or outrage of modesty or injury to a student.

- All the students are expected to abide by the rules in force.
- A student is expected to behave decently with all members of the teaching staff, office staff and with all supporting staff.
- Students should refrain from loitering in the corridors or standing in the verandas during working hours. The leisure periods may be utilised in the Library or Reading Room.
- Every student should carry his/her Identity Card with him/her daily.
- If a student is absent from the college for more than fifteen days continuously without leave of absence, his name will be removed from the rolls.

Semester Examinations

The college follows Semester system of "Instruction and Examination". The details are:

- ◆ There will be two semesters in each academic year.
- ◆ There will be final examination at the end of each semester.
- ◆ If a student has failed or likes to improve on his/her marks obtained in a semester, he/she is allowed to appear or improve during the next semester.
- ◆ Students can improve their marks of the semester examination, provided they clear all the papers of that semester.
- ◆ The students are given only one chance to improve on the marks obtained in a semester by appearing in the next immediate semester examination.
- ◆ There will be no detention at the end of first, third and fifth semester.
- ◆ There will be detention at the end of the second and fourth semester. If a student fails in more than 50% of the total papers of first and second semester, he will be detained at the end of second semester. If a student fails in more than 25% of first, second, third and fourth semester put together he will be detained at the end of fourth semester.

Second Languages Offered

- ❖ The college offers Telugu/Hindi/Sanskrit/Urdu/Arabic subjects as Second Language.

Attendance

- A Minimum of 75% of attendance is compulsory for the students to appear for the semester examinations and for obtaining scholarships.
- The attendance shall be calculated from the date of commencement of the classes as per the almanac of Govt. City College (Autonomous).

Internal Assessment

Students are required to write two Internal Assessment examinations in each paper in each subject as a part of continuous Internal Evaluation. The maximum marks in each paper are 10. The student has to write compulsorily two Internal Assessments in each paper and the average of the two marks obtained will be taken into account for the end examination result.

End Examination (Each semester / Evaluation)

The maximum marks in the theory paper in each subject in each paper is 50 (end exam, each semester) and the Internal Assessment is 10. The student has to get a minimum of 22 out of 60, (50+10) to pass in each paper of the examination and the minimum pass mark in the end exam, each paper in the theory subject is 18.

Project Work (Sixth Semester)

The students of sixth semester should submit a Project Work in a subject of their choice and the details of which will be intimated by the subject faculty. The Project Work is compulsory for every student and a minimum pass in the Project Work is to be obtained before the declaration of the final result and award of degree. Grades will be awarded for the Project Work and these grades will be notified in the Memorandum of Marks of the sixth semester examinations and consolidated memorandum of marks. The details of the Project Work will be intimated to the students by the college at the beginning of the fifth semester.

IMPORTANT LIBRARY RULES

- ✦ The final year students can borrow two books at a time for a period of 15 days and the rest of the students only one book.
- ✦ A late fee of 50 paise, per day per book, is charged if the book is not returned within the stipulated period.
- ✦ When books are lost by any member, one and a half times cost of the book has to be paid.
- ✦ Students will not be allowed to keep the books with them during the vacation. The books should be returned before the last day of instruction or at least before the issue of the hall-ticket. No student is permitted to retain them after that date.
- ✦ Marking and scribbling on books is strictly forbidden. If the book is damaged it should be replaced at once together with fine.
- ✦ Reference books and Journals are not issued to the students.

RECOMMENDATIONS OF THE UGC COMMITTEE ON AUTONOMY :

Tenure conferred / extended by the OSMANIA UNIVERSITY, HYDERABAD as Autonomous College.

The proposal to consider the college for grant of autonomy as submitted by Osmania University dated 20-8-2001 and simultaneous concurrence given by the Govt. of Andhra Pradesh in 2001-2002 was duly considered by the UGC. As per the UGC order no. F 2-5/2000(Desk –AC) dated 21-may-2004, UGC has sent an expert committee and agreed to grant autonomous status by Osmania University for the period from 2004 to 2010. The Osmania University has granted this status on 2/3-9-2004 for a period of FIVE years.

Since the procedure of granting extension of autonomous status to any college still lies with the affiliating University, the recommendations of this Expert Committee shall be communicated to the University as per UGC guidelines. As the University nominee was also a part of this Expert Committee, the University may consider the recommendations accordingly.

This committee is satisfied with the performance of this college and recommends that the tenure of autonomous status be extended for another period of FIVE Years.

Tenure conferred . extended by the GOVERNMENT OF ANDHRA PRADESH.

The state government is yet to issue any intimation for extension of autonomy after the year 2010. However, the nominee of the State Council for Higher Education was also present during this expert committee visit of the College, the recommendations of this committee shall be suitably considered as per norms.
