### FEE REIMBURSEMENT / ELIGIBILITY FOR SCHOLARSHIP DETAILS

The student whose parents/guardians income is less than Rs. 1,00,000/. (BC. OBC, BC(E), EBC) and Rs. 2,00,000/- for SC. ST, per annum are instructed to apply for scholarship and reimbursement of tuition fee by the Social Welfare /Tribal Welfare / Backward Classes & Minority Welfare Department through "ONLINE" on the website <http://epasswebsite.cgg.gov.in> and fill up the relevant columns through "ONLINE" submission only. The printed copy of "online" scholarship form along with the enclosures has to be submitted in the Scholarship Section of the College without fail for getting the scholarship and tuition fee reimbursement. The following certificates are to be enclosed along with the printout copy of online scholarship form and submit at the scholarship section of the college: Originals and 2 (two) sets of xerox Copies.

### **GOLD MEDALS**

Forty Seven (47) Gold Medals will be awarded to the meritorious students every year on the College Annual Day. Academic prizes are also awarded for the meritorious students during each year.

### **COMPUTERS**

The College has five well equipped computer laboratories to provide training in computer classes at the undergraduate level. Internet facility is available free of cost for the benefit of the students. The department of computer science conducts computer courses for non-computer students at regular intervals.

### **TSKC & LANGUAGE LAB**

Telangana Skills and Knowledge Centre provides training to the learners in employable skills. It works on creating opportunities, developing skills and unleashing Potential.

There are 50 clients connected to 2 high-end servers at TSKC Lab and 30 stand alone PCs at Language Lab to cater to the Warning need of the students in the latest times.

### **SEMESTER SYSTEM OF INSTRUCTION & EVALUATION**

- There will be two semesters in 'each academic year.
- There will be final examination at the end of each semester.
- If a students has failed he/she is allowed to appear during the next semester.
- Improvements is allowed in the next immediate semester exams.
- There will be no detention at the end of first, third & fifth semester.
- There will be detention at the end of the second and fourth semester.
- If a student fails in more than 50% of the total papers of first and second semester, he will be detained at the end of second semester. If a student falls in more than 50% of first, second, third and fourth semester put together he will be detained at the end of fourth semester.

### **INTERNAL ASSESSMENT**

Students are required to write two Internal Assessment examinations in each paper in each subject of every semester as a part of internal evaluation. The maximum marks for internal assessment examinations carries 15. Another 5 marks are allotted for continuous internal evalautaiion i.e., based on attendance, assignments, seminars, etc. The students has to write compulsorily two internal assessments and also submit assignments in each paper which carries.

### **CBCS AND CHOICE BASED CREDIT SYSTEM**

The college has adopted Semester System and Choice Based Credit System from the year 2014. The semester system accelerates the teaching-learning process and enables vertical and horizontal mobility in learning. The credit based semester system provides flexibility in designing curriculum and assigning credits based on the course content and hours of teaching. The choice based credit system provides a 'cafeteria' type approach. In which the students can take courses of their choice,

learn at their own pace, undergo additional courses and acquire more than the required credits, and adopt an interdisciplinary approach to learning.

## **GRADING SYSTEM**

- The performance of the student is evaluated in terms of percentage of marks with a provision of or conversion to grade points. A student earns credit in each paper only if she obtains minimum pass marks in each subject A minimum of 125 credits are required for the award of degree.
- Candidates who have passed all the examinations of B.A/B.Com/B.Sc. Degree Course shall be awarded division in accordance with the grade secured by them in all I. II. III. IV. V & VI semester Examinations in I, II and III years taken together, including the Internal assessment marks secured in those years.
- A minimum Cumulative Grade Point Average (CGPA) of 4 is required for the award of degree. The consolidated memorandum of marks reflects the credits/grade scored in each subject and the credits/grades scored in IDE's. Add on Courses and NSS / NCC / Sports / Certified Voluntary work. However, courses under part III except IDE and part IV will not be included for the calculation of SGPA and CGPA.
- Grades are also allotted to Inter disciplinary electives. Add on courses and NSS/NCC/Sports/Any Voluntary Certified work based on the individual performance of the student.
- A candidate shall be deemed to have fully passed the examination PROJECT WORK The students of sixth semester should submit a Project Work in a subject of their choice and the details of which we be intimated by the subject faculty. The Project Work is compulsory for every student and a minimum pass in the Project Work is to be obtained before the declaration of the final result and award of degree. Grades will be awarded for the Project Work and these grades will be notified in the Memorandum of Marks of the sixth semester examinations. The details of the Project Work will be intimated to the students by the college at the beginning of the fifth semester.
